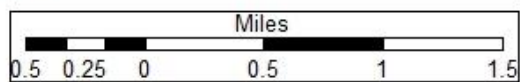
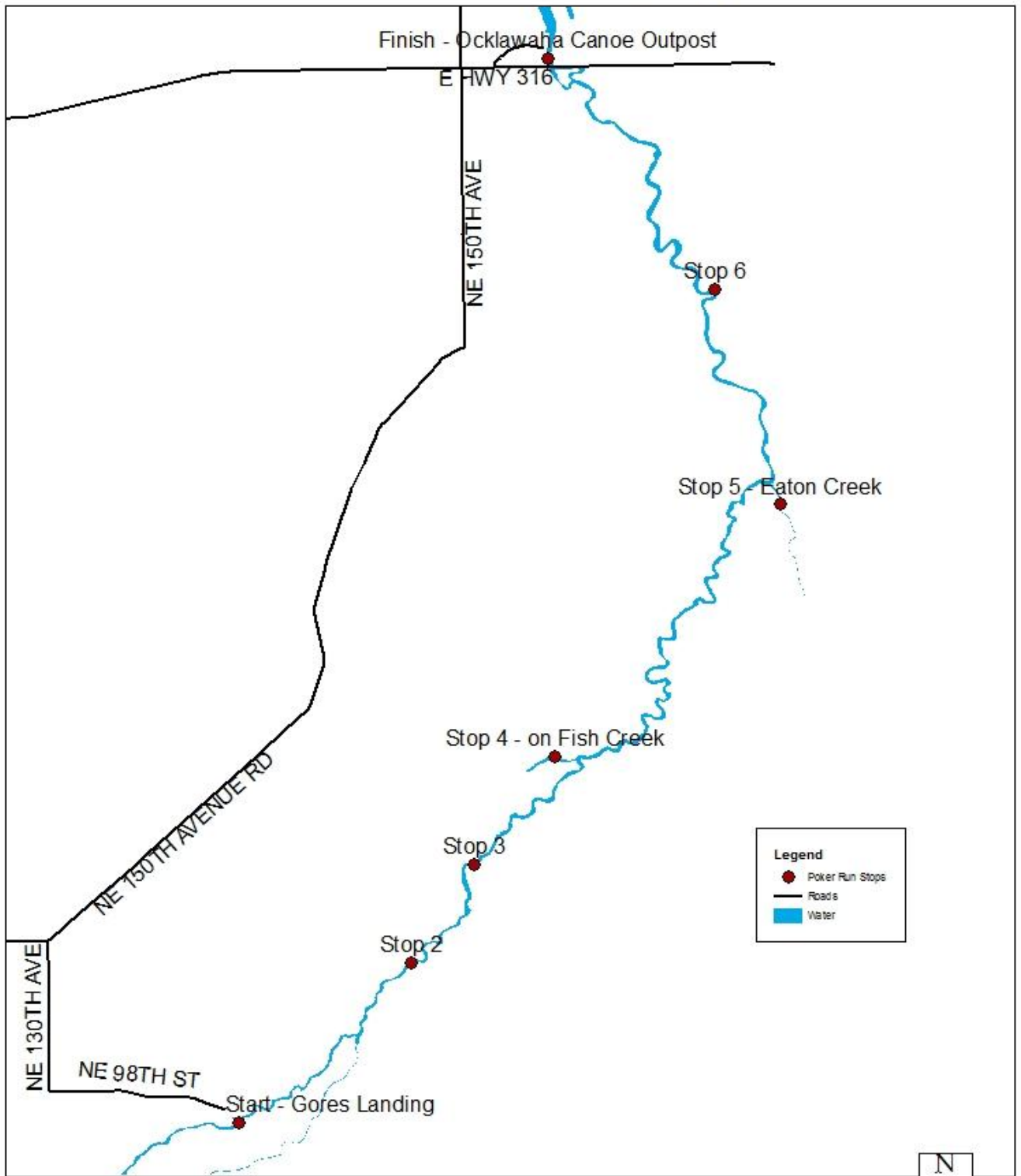
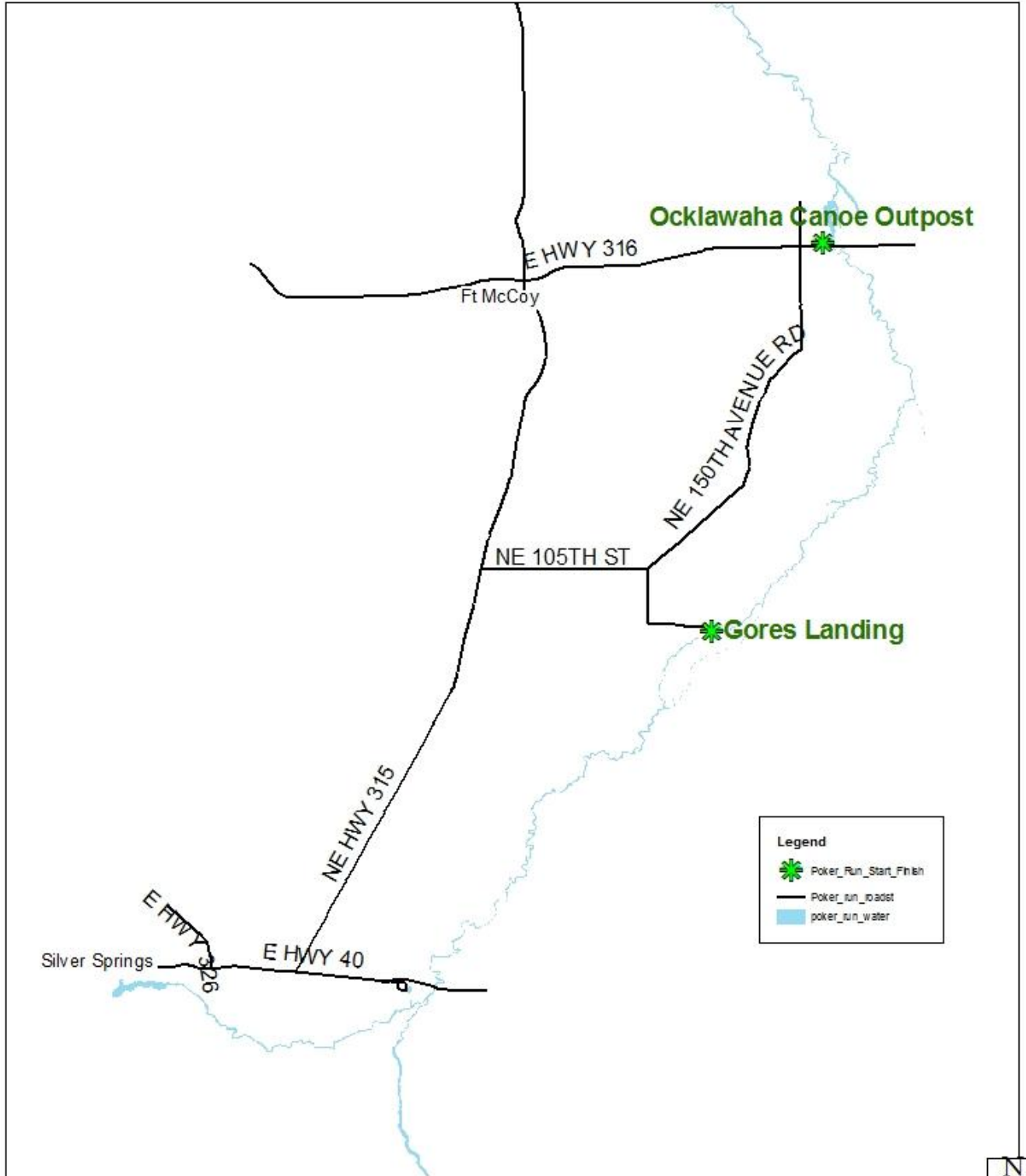


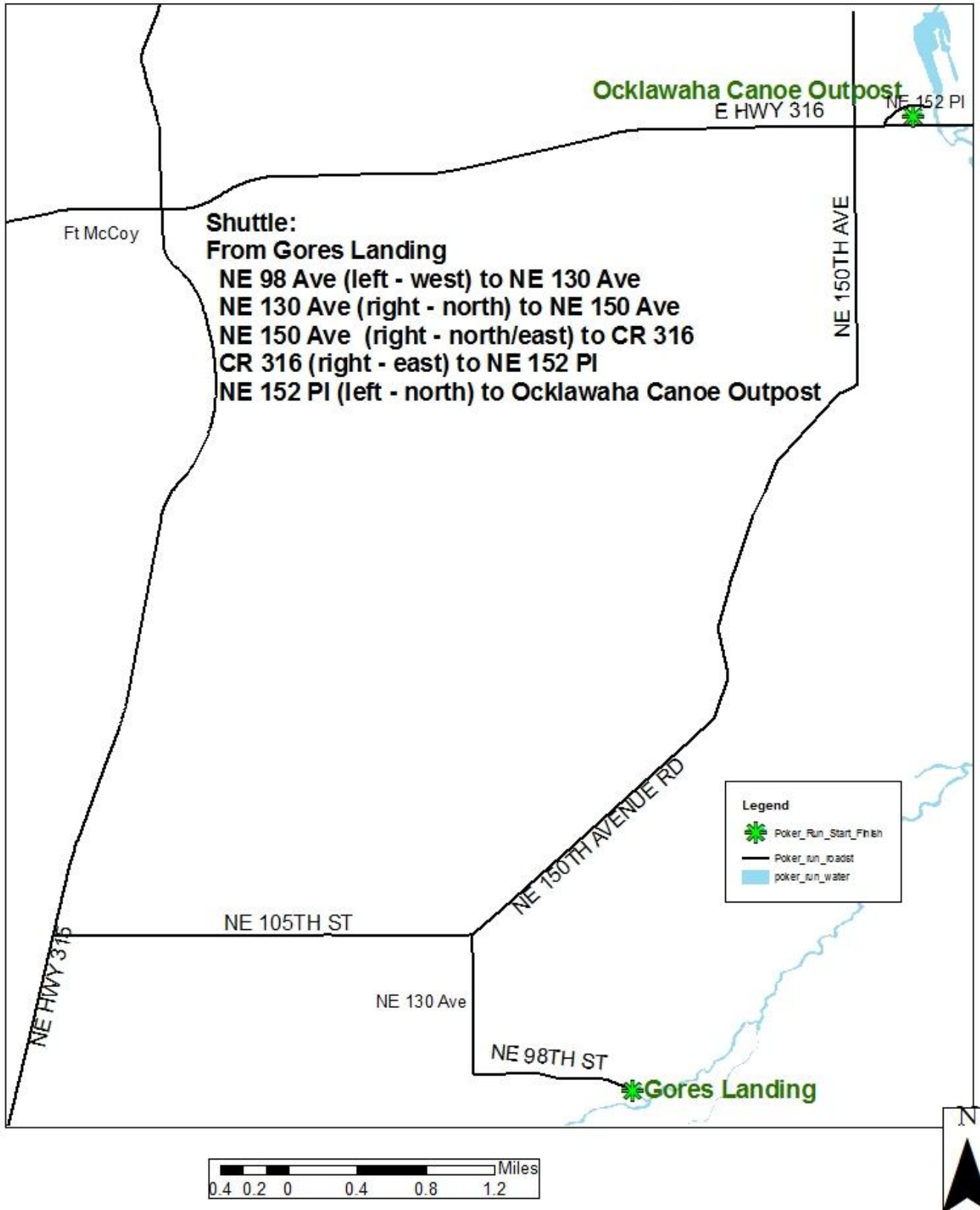
Poker Run Paddling Map

The 2010 Paddlers Poker Run

The distance from Gores Landing to Ocklawaha Canoe Outpost with Side Trips onto Fish Creek and Eaton Creek is approximately 9 ¼ miles. We need all participants to be at the end no later than 4:30 so that we can shuttle all up in time to start at 5 pm.

Boats can be placed on water as early as 9 am, once registration process is completed.

Below are estimated distances between stops and estimated times to paddle. You should strive to be completed at each stop no later than the time shown. This is at rate of 1.5 miles per hour, which is a very slow paddle, but allows time for you to have lunch/snacks and maybe swim along the river.

A “Sweep” will be at end of participants – they will monitor times and suggest you paddle faster “if” you run risk of being late.

The Ocklawaha Canoe Outpost is on the left (west) side of the river after you pass under the CR 316 Bridge.

At the end we’ll have trailers for your canoe/or kayak to be toted on back to the parking lot. We plan to drop off the boats at a “drop zone” and we’ll assist you, as we are able, to move your boat from there to your vehicle. We ask that once your boat is loaded on the trailer; that you walk on to the parking lot. We will not be able to monitor what belongs to whom, please consider this before leaving personal belongings in the boat.

Due to the number of vehicles, numbers of people walking, the narrowness of the ramp area, it would be unwise for you to drive down to the ramp to collect your boat and belongings.

At the Ocklawaha Canoe Outpost we’ll have a pulled pork sandwich with beans and chips and lemonade for \$5.00, which we’ll begin selling at 2 pm.

Poker Hands

At each Stop (1-7) you will draw 1 card from a bag containing 7 decks. The card will be marked with your Registration Number and the Stop number. By placing the Registration Number and the Stop number on each card it prevents potential mixing of hands. *(At each stop a tally sheet will be marked that your number has pulled their card for that stop)*

When you draw your card – confirm that it is NOT a duplicate card of what you already have, as two cards of the same value and same suit do not count!! This must be done BEFORE the card is marked with your number.

At the end you should have 7 cards, you choose the best 5 cards for your hand – it is up to you to stop at all 7 locations, if you miss a stop – your options become more limited.

The individual with the highest poker hand will receive the top prize. Only the top 5 hands will receive monies, all other winning hands will receive a prize donated from a business or individual. The total number of winning hands is determined by total prizes available, we will continue until all prizes are awarded. The Cash prizes 1st-5th decrease by 7% each.

Additional Poker Hands may be purchased for \$5 each. These will be marked with an “X” and your extra hand number and the Stop number.

Winning hands will be awarded in the following order; it will be possible for multiple winning HANDS. When that occurs the highest high card wins. (Example; 2 people have 4 of a kind but one is of 3’s and other is 9’s, the 9’s are a higher winner than the 3’s.

Royal Flush	<u>AKQJ10</u>	Same suit
Straight Flush	<u>45678</u>	Same suit
Four of a Kind	<u>66668</u>	Any suit
Full House	<u>KKK33</u>	Any suit
Flush	5 cards within same suit	Same suit
Straight	<u>56789</u>	Any suit
Three of a Kind	<u>44453</u>	Any suit
Two Pair	<u>KK883</u>	Any suit
One Pair	<u>88532</u>	Any suit
High Card	<u>KQ975</u>	Any suit

***Should we have 2 or more individuals that tie with Royal flushes – we’ll average 1st prize with 2nd (and third prize if required) so ties will receive same cash amount.
